### General Information

- Date:** Enrichment classes and athletic camps begin on a variety of dates. Close attention should be given to the beginning and ending dates.

- Place:** Please note the location of each class/camp offered. Based upon the grade level of the classes/camps offered, all ERE opportunities for Summer 2009 will be held at PVE, ZMS, ZCHS and ZCHS Freshman Center (FC).
- Cost:** Classes/camps have varying costs. Each individual instructor has determined the fee.
- Transportation:** The Corporation does not provide transportation to ERE classes/camps except for students enrolled in the Z'Care Summer Extended Experience. Parents are asked to bring children no earlier than ten minutes prior to the start of the class/camp, and to pick them up promptly at the end of the class/camp.
- Behavior:** Students who interfere with the progress of other students will be dismissed from the program without a refund of fees.
- Courses:** On the following pages, you will find descriptions of the classes/camps offered and the locations, dates, times, and fees.
- Grade Levels:** **REFERS TO GRADE PLACEMENT IN THE 2009-10 SCHOOL YEAR with the exception of Football Camp and Boys' Basketball Camp.**

### Registration

5. All withdrawals must be made before the first day of class/camp in order to receive a refund.
